18 LEARNER PROFILE "INQUIRER"

Asalam o Alaikum

Through this newsletter as a medium we would like to talk and explain about the attribute of the IB learner profile "Inquirer".

What does inquiry look like in a PYP Classroom and at home?

An inquirer shows a natural curiosity and seeks out answers to questions. According to the Primary years Program, inquirers nurture their curiosity, developing skills for inquiry and research. Inquirers learn independently and with others showing enthusiasm and sustaining their love of learning throughout life. (IBO, 2013)

How can parents help to promote inquiry at home?



- Encourage your child to read newspaper articles and borrow books from the library which have their focus on the unit of inquiry.
- Show great enthusiasm when you find your child inquiring into a new concept.
- Model being an Inquirer. Seek the answers by researching with your child rather than simply telling what you already know.
- Use internet together with your child to explore new ideas and information.
- Explore practical use of math concepts in real life situations: for example, use of percentage in price tags, use of decimals in money and use of weight in different products available in the market.
